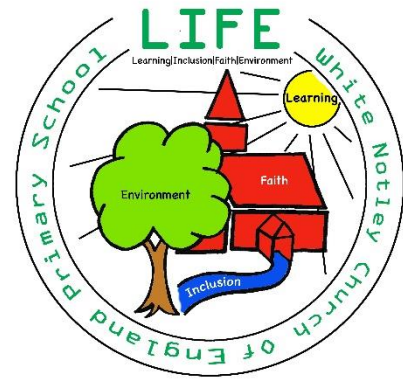

Dear Parents,

Our vision for everyone at White Notley is to flourish and grow by living life to the full, through **Learning**, **Inclusion**, **Faith** and **Environment**.
